

This week is going to be very exciting! Many of you and your children may have noticed there are a few rides in the church parking lot already. The tents will go up a little each day, so this means we won't be able to park in the school parking lots at dismissal. So, we will be utilizing "Country Fair Parking" as early as today. For new families and those that have forgotten, "Country Fair Parking" means teachers will walk students over to the church parking lot, and parents will need to park in the church parking lot. 






- Football, Cross Country, Cheer, Basketball and Kickball participants from each West Deanery school will be recognized


St. Malachy Ministry Notes


